Reading Comprehension

Questions:

Who builds the snowman?

What do Mia and Alex use for the snowman's nose?

Where does the snowman stand?

Grandma bakes Christmas cookies. Tom helps her in the kitchen. They make star and tree-shaped cookies. The cookies are decorated with icing and sprinkles.

Questions:

Who bakes Christmas cookies?

What shapes are the cookies?

How are the cookies decorated?



Reading Comprehension



The school is having a Christmas play. Lily is an angel, and her friend Ben is a shepherd. They wear costumes and perform in front of their families. Everyone claps and cheers at the end.

Questions:

What event is happening at the school?

What roles do Lily and Ben play?

What do the audience do after the play?

Sarah and her mom go shopping for Christmas gifts. They buy toys for children in need. Sarah feels happy to help others. On Christmas day, they donate the gifts to a local charity.

Questions:

Who goes shopping for Christmas gifts?

What type of gifts do they buy?

How does Sarah feel about giving gifts?

Questions:

What does the town do every December?

Who helps Ethan with the Christmas lights?
